**WHEREAS**, the City of Maple Heights, Ohio (the "GRANTEE") is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("NOPEC") and is Eligible for one or more NOPEC Energized Community Grant(s) for 2022 ("NEC Grant(s)") as provided for in the NEC Grant Program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the GRANTEE wishes to enter into a Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. in substantially the form presented to this Council to receive one or more NEC Grant(s).

WHEREAS, the Maple Heights Land Reutilization Program fosters the return of non-productive land to tax revenue generating status or the dedication thereof to public use; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) seeks to revitalize neighborhoods, promote economic growth and create job and workforce development opportunities, and assists local governments in effective use and re-use of vacant property; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) owns the following vacant parcel in the City of Maple Heights, which it desires to transfer to the Maple Heights Land Reutilization Program according to the Conveyance Agreement available in the Office of the Housing Manager:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Conveyance Agreement with the Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC), a copy of which is available in the office of the Housing Manager, and the Maple Heights Land Reutilization Program is authorized to accept title to the following vacant parcel in the City of Maple Heights, and as listed in the Cuyahoga County Records for the Land Bank in the City of Maple Heights:

## PPN: 782-14-078 21001 HILLGROVE AVENUE

Section 2. The Director of Finance is authorized, upon passage of this Ordinance, to send certified copies of this Ordinance to the County Auditor and the County Fiscal Officer requesting that the above-listed vacant parcel in the City of Maple Heights, identified by its respective permanent parcel number, and as listed in the Cuyahoga County Records, be exempted from taxation for this City owned property.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH AMATO HOMES I, LLC TO SELL THREE (3) VACANT LOTS LOCATED AT 15720 ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 786-03-015); V/L ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 783-03-046); AND 5540 SOUTH BOULEVARD (PPN 783-01-017) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND SALE OF A SINGLE FAMILY, OWNER-OCCUPIED HOME ON EACH PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Amato Homes I, LLC ("the Developer") has advised the Mayor and Economic Development Director that it desires to purchase the three (3) vacant lots owned by the City located at 15720 ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 786-03-015); V/L ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 783-03-046); and 5540 SOUTH BOULEVARD (PPN 783-01-017), (each referred to as the "Property", and together as the "Properties") for the construction and sale of a single family, owner-occupied home on each property; and

WHEREAS, the Properties are owned by the City through its Land Reutilization Program and the Mayor desires to sell the lots to the Developer, with the Developer required to build the homes within 360 days of title transfer and to make the following minimum improvements: 1) the homes must be an owner-occupied single family colonial style home; and 2) the homes must have at least 1200 square feet, three (3) bedrooms and two and one-half (2.5) baths. In addition, the Developer may split 15720 Rockside Road (PPN 786-03-015) into two equal parcels of approximately 52-foot frontage, provided that the Maple Heights Planning and Zoning Commission approves the split and a variance from the 60-foot frontage requirement. In that event, Developer may build one home on each new parcel; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to R.C. 5722.07, the fair market value of the lots, as determined by the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer, and after taking into account the required minimum improvements, is \$500.00 per lot.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Amato Homes I, LLC ("the Developer") to sell the three (3) vacant lots owned by the City located at 15720 ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 786-03-015); V/L ROCKSIDE ROAD (PPN 783-03-046); and 5540 SOUTH BOULEVARD (PPN 783-01-017) (collectively referred to as "the Properties"), at a sales price of \$500.00 each, for a total sale price of \$1,500.00, with the Developer required to build the homes within 360 days of title transfer and to make the following minimum improvements: 1) the homes must be an owner-occupied single family colonial style home; and 2) the homes must have at least 1200 square feet, three (3) bedrooms and two and one-half (2.5) baths. In addition, the Developer may split 15720 Rockside Road (PPN 786-03-015) into two equal parcels of approximately 52-foot frontage, provided that the Maple Heights Planning and Zoning Commission approves the split and a variance from the 60-foot frontage requirement. In that event, Developer may build one home on each new parcel. A copy of the Agreement is available in the office of the Director of Economic Development and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2. Pursuant to R.C. 5722.07, the fair market value of the Properties, as determined by the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer, and after taking into account the time to build and required minimum improvements, is \$500.00 per lot. Pursuant to R.C. 5722.08 all of the proceeds from the sale of the Properties shall be used to maintain the remaining parcels of real property held by the City in its Land Reutilization Program.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor, Economic Development Director and the Law Director are authorized to prepare, sign and file with the County Recorder and Fiscal Officer all documents, and tender any closing fees necessary as the Seller to effect the transfer of the Properties from the City to the Developer, Amato Homes I, LLC.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Economic Development Director have proposed a grant program known as the 2022 Exterior Maintenance Grant Program, the terms of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, to provide owners who occupy their homes with financial assistance to maintain the exterior of their homes as a way to preserve and promote the curb appeal of homes in the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The 2022 Exterior Maintenance Grant Program, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, is approved. WHEREAS, on November 3, 2021, by Resolution 2021-131, Council authorized and directed the Mayor to enter into a 2022 Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) agreement with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) for the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project in the City of Maple Heights which included the field investigation, testing, other research, and preparation of plans and specifications for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets including Dunham, Turney, Carol, Summit, Rochelle, Lisa, Janet, James, Wheeler, E. 146, Mustang, Thunderbird, and appurtenant easement areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights had been awarded Two Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$292,320.00) by the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, through the 2022 Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) agreement of cooperation with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD), the City of Maple Heights will be responsible for One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$125,280.00) of the cost of the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area will allow the City of Maple Heights to submit future funding applications to various public agencies, including the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) and the Ohio Public Works Commission (ORWC); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has informed the Mayor and Service Director that his engineering firm, Chagrin Valley Engineering (CVE), is prepared to begin the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project and will utilize the services of AECOM to provide engineering services not provided by CVE including televising, dye investigation, and miscellaneous field testing, as a subcontractor, per the terms of the existing engineering services agreement between the City of Maple Heights and CVE.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Engineer is hereby authorized to begin the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The Council of the City of Maple Heights hereby authorizes the Finance Director to amend the appropriations as required for the expenditures outlined within this Resolution.
- Section 3.
