WHEREAS, on November 3, 2021, by Resolution No. 2021-131, Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a 2022 Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) agreement with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) for the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project in the City of Maple Heights which included the field investigation, testing, other research, and preparation of plans and specifications for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets including Dunham, Turney, Carol, Summit, Rochelle, Lisa, Janet, James, Wheeler, E. 146th, Mustang, Thunderbird, and appurtenant easement areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights had been awarded Two Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$292,320.00) by the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, through the 2022 Member Community Infrastructure Program (MCIP) agreement of cooperation with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD), the City of Maple Heights will be responsible for One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$125,280.00) of the cost of the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-15, Council authorized the City Engineer to begin the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including necessary engineering reports for the repair of storm and sanitary sewers on various streets within the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, The City Engineer has advised the Mayor that he will require the acquisition of a temporary sewer easement at 14368 Rochelle Drive for the repairs and future maintenance of the storm and

sanitary sewers facilities on the property which are a part of the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the property located at 14368 Rochelle Drive, Permanent Parcel No. 785-11-034 within the City of Maple Heights, will be offered appropriate consideration to grant a temporary sewer easement for the repairs and future maintenance of the storm and sanitary sewers facilities on the property which are a part of the Southwest Sewer District Sewer Repairs Phase 2 Project area; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize and to accept these easements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights seeks to make improvements to its existing wastewater facilities by improving sanitary sewers and eliminating sanitary sewer overflow; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights intends to apply for a 2025 Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Principal Forgiveness loan to fund a portion of the cost of construction of the Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 3 Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) requires the governing authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights is a local government eligible to receive Funding for an eligible activity through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Program Year 2025 Final Program Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Engineer have advised Council that 2025 WPCLF Principal Forgiveness funds may be available through the Ohio EPA's Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Eight Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$208,000.00), to fund a portion of the Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 3 Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application, sign and file all necessary contracts and documents with the Ohio EPA's Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA) for funding through the 2025 WPCLF Principal Forgiveness loan program for the following project:

Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 3 Project

Section 2. The dedicated source of repayment will be Maple Heights Water Fund 219.

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights, upon application of the City Engineer, was awarded a grant in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$475,448.00) for the Libby Road Watermain Replacement Project, from Broadway Avenue to Lee Road, ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2021, by Resolution No. 2021-33, Council authorized the City Engineer to begin the preparation of plans and specifications and to provide advertising for bids for the Libby Road Watermain Replacement Project in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) is contributing up to Thirty Percent (30%) of the cost, up to a maximum of Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$418,500.00), for the watermain replacement and additional work, including the resurfacing of Libby Road, from Broadway Avenue to Lee Road, under the Libby Road Waterline and Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2025 the bids for the Libby Road Watermain Replacement and Resurfacing Project were opened and inspected by the City Engineer to determine the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Council of the City of Maple Heights hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Northeast Ohio Trenching Service, Inc., for the Libby Road Watermain Replacement and Resurfacing Project, for a cost not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Forty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$1,541,760.24), as more fully described in the bid record on file in the Office of the Finance Director of the City of Maple Heights

WHEREAS, child abuse is 100% preventable and the cost of treating the impacts of child abuse is significantly higher than the cost of preventing it; and

WHEREAS, consistent, early and effective prevention strategies have been proven to save lives, protect resources and strengthen and preserve Cuyahoga County's families by ending cycles of abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, children raised in safe, stable and nurturing environments are more likely to enjoy good physical and mental health, succeed academically and socially and achieve economic prosperity; and

WHEREAS, educating adults about how to use positive coping skills, seek options, and be flexible enables them to be stronger, more resilient individuals throughout their lives and create more stable environments and brighter futures for children; and

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect prevention is a community responsibility, and on behalf of Cuyahoga County's children, we join with Canopy Child Advocacy Center; and

WHEREAS, during the month of April and throughout the year we encourage everyone to come together against child abuse and neglect by supporting prevention programs, so every child feels safe and nurtured and each family receives the support and education needed; and

WHEREAS, guided by the wisdom of Frederick Douglass that it is easier to build strong children than to repair broken adult, we all resolve to do our part to build strong children with safe, healthy futures.
