DISTRICT 2 ROAD RESURFACING FOR 2024

Roads to be resurfaced will be Maple Park Drive, Maplewood Avenue from Glenwood to Eastwood, and Steinway from Dunham to Glenwood. Approval for the City to go out to bid on these street will be at the June 5th Council meeting. Work to begin early Fall.

Roadwork that began last Fall on Eastwood, Glenwood and West, East and South Glenn will have the final chip seal completed by early June.

James Avenue is scheduled for resurfacing next year. In early Fall NEORS D will be replacing the sewer lines on the street in preparation for the new pavement. James Avenue will be repaved at no cost to taxpayers through the many grants we received for the sewer replacement. Rockside Road resurfacing is scheduled for 2025 with the help of a \$2.3 million dollar grant from the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACCA).
