



City of Maple Heights Tips for Trash

Trash Times

- Pickup Days:
 - Thursday: North of Broadway Ave
 - Friday: South of Broadway Ave
- Trash containers should be placed at the curb the evening before collection day, no earlier than 6:00 p.m.
- Trash containers should be returned to storage behind rear building line before 8:00 a.m. the day after collection
- Noncompliance could lead to citations/fines from the City

Bulk Items

- No more than 2 bulk items or bags each collection day (in addition to completely filled can)
- Bulk item pickup must be scheduled in advance. Please visit City website to fill out a heavy item request form [here](#)
- Upholstered Furniture, Mattresses, and Box Springs: Must be wrapped in plastic with duct tape or packing tape (no fabric exposed)
- Lumber: Bundle and tie in lengths no longer than 3 ft and 40 pounds
- Carpet: Cut, roll, and tie in lengths no longer than 4 ft

Extra Trash Can

- For extra can, please call Waste Management at (866) 797-9018
- Cost for additional can is \$4/ month- billed annually (\$48)

Holidays

- If holiday occurs on or before collection day, service will be delayed one day that week only
- 2023 Observed Holidays: New Years Day (Jan 1st), Independence Day (Jul 4th), Thanksgiving Day (Nov 23rd), Memorial Day (May 29th), Labor Day (Sep 4th), Christmas Day (Dec 25th)

Recycling

- Collected every other week
- Do not bag: Place empty recyclable materials directly into recycling can
- Food containers must be rinsed and free of food debris
- Flatten and bundle boxes if recycling can is full
- Acceptable items: Plastic bottles and containers, paper, glass bottles and containers, flattened cardboard boxes, food and beverage cans
- Nonacceptable items: Foods or liquids, foam cups and containers, green waste, batteries, loose plastic bags, clothing, furniture, or carpet
