

ENBRIDGE EAST OHIO GAS UPGRADE WORK

FRIEND & LEE – MLR - PIR # 3515

CONSTRUCTION START: TUESDAY MARCH 3, 2026

Enbridge East Ohio Gas is continuing to upgrade their natural gas transmission and distribution system in the City of Maple Heights. Enbridge Project FRIEND & LEE – MLR - PIR # 3515 will include work to upgrade gas mains and service connections on Lee Road between Libby Road and Mill Creek, Friend Avenue west of Lee Road, Raymond Street east of Lee Road and Libby Road east of Lee Road. All residents that will be directly affected by these upgrades have been previously notified by Dominion. **The area of construction is shown below:**



The contractor will begin mobilizing for construction on **Tuesday March 3, 2026**. The work will utilize directional drilling, which eliminates the need for excessive open cut excavations and minimizes disruptions to driveway access, for the construction of the 4 inch and 8 inch gas mains located outside of the pavement area. **A new 20 inch gas main is being installed through the full project length of Lee Road within the curb lane pavement area on the west side of the roadway. This work will require an open cut excavation process to install the gas main.** Smaller excavated areas will be required at service connections to the 4 inch and 8 inch gas mains. The City's construction inspection firm, Quality Control Inspection (QCI), will be providing inspection for this project and all disturbed areas will be restored to original or better condition when the project is completed.

One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Lee Road. Temporary lane closures will be required at times and the contractor will be using flaggers to direct traffic in such cases. Please proceed with caution through the work zone for your safety and the safety of the construction workers. If work is occurring directly in front of your house, you may temporarily lose access to your driveway. The contractor will provide 24-hour notice if this is likely to occur, and they will work to restore access to your driveway as soon as work progresses past your driveway.

Thank you for your cooperation during this work. We appreciate your patience and cooperation and will post additional notices as required during the construction period.
